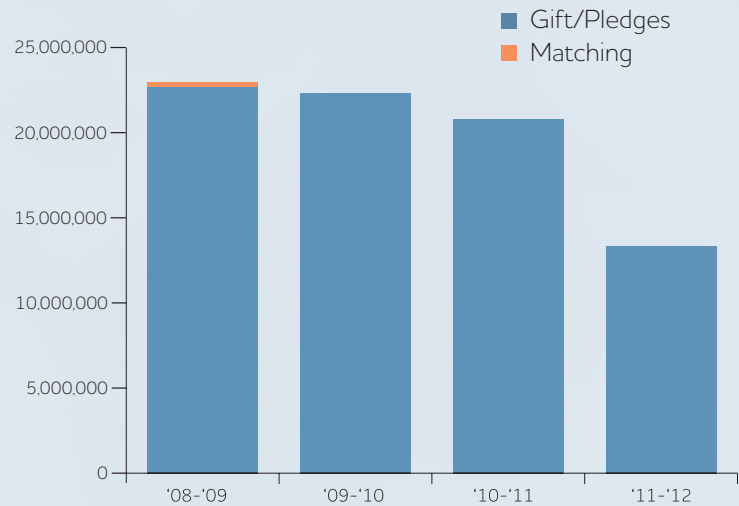


Gift Summary for 2011-2012

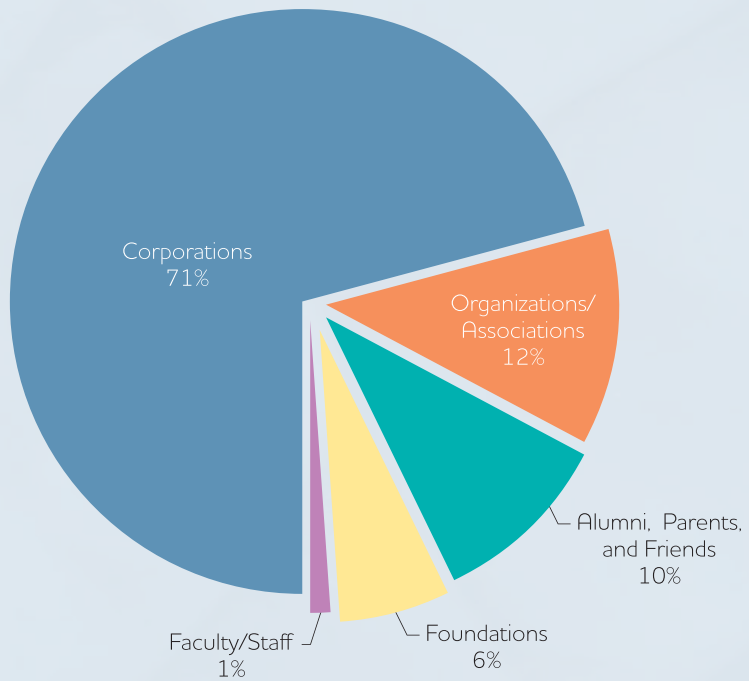

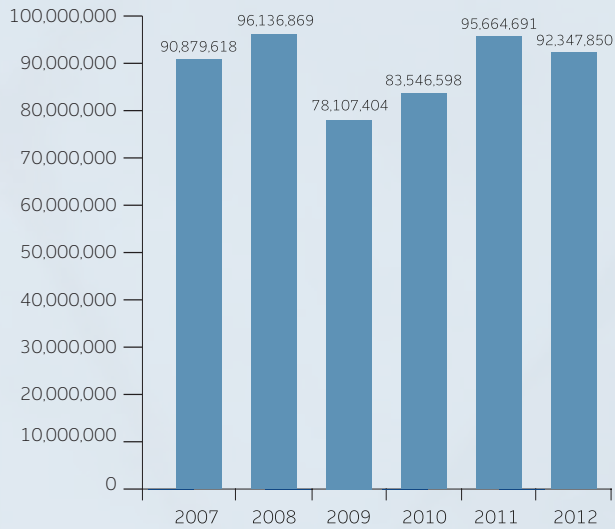


IFAS Endowment Growth

Endowments are permanent, named funds that provide annual, renewable support for donor designated IFAS programs. The endowment donor designates the use of endowment earnings for an IFAS area or program of choice. The minimum gift required to establish an endowed fund is \$30,000.

Endowment assets are managed and invested by the University of Florida Foundation through the University of Florida Investment Corporation (UFICO), created in 2004 to manage UF's investment portfolio. As of June 30, 2012, there are more than 250 IFAS endowment funds valued at more than \$90 million that were established by individual alumni, businesses, organizations, associations and friends – with 116 of those added since the Florida Tomorrow Capital Campaign began in July 2005.
